Waiver procedure for School Ball

Here are the steps to follow in order to obtain a Waiver for a player who has participated on a school baseball team during the regular school season and is unable to fulfill Rule 11.03 1d on Page 25. The Babe Ruth league president has the option to seek a waiver for a player who has been playing school ball during the leagues regular season and unable to fulfill Rule 11.03 1d.

- 1. A letter from the High School coach or designated administrator at the school, indicating that the player was a member of the school team and indicating when the player was released to play on a Babe Ruth regular season team.
- 2. Babe Ruth regular season schedule, showing all games played during the regular season.
- 3. District Commissioner will review the information above and determine the number of games needed to be played on the Babe Ruth team in order to determine eligibility. (Normally ½ of the games remaining on the regular season schedule.
- 4. District Commissioner along with the State Commissioner will determine if the player qualifies for a waiver for Rule 11.03 1d.

Leagues who anticipate having players who might want to take advantage of this waiver procedure, should make every effort to schedule regular season games, so that players on school teams have enough games to play to be considered eligible. Leagues should also consider the other players in the league who have played the entire season and the effect this might cause within the league.
